Gay Liberation Front is a revolutionary bomosexual group of men and women torneed with the realization that complete sexual liberation for all people cannot come about unless existing social institutions are abolished. # ALL POINTS BUILDETING

The following is a paraphrase of a Police report on the Gay Liberation Front. It was given to Martha Shelley by a source who wishes to remain unidentified:

"The Gay Liberation Front is a radical and ravelutionery organization, based on energhist guidelines, similar to the Black Panthus and Weathermen. The organization is worth watching, although there seem to be only one or two radical individuals present at any given time. There is no immediate threat. They represent themselves as a homophile promization but are unlike such respectable and dedicated organizations as DOR and Mattachine

It's nice to know we're in good company.

Some of the names of staff menabers appearing in this issue are pseudonyms. In one or two instances they are names which are used in all writings, in others they are being used because discresure as a homosowial could megn the loss of a job, family difficulties and similar problems. We recognize this as one form of our oppression that we are all struggling against - and we are all at different seets of working it out,

The decision to accept articles written under oseudo nyms was a difficult one to make. On the one pend, we felt that a part of "Coming Out" was to write under one's own name; we falt, too, that this was especially impuritagit because of what we on "Come Gut" are trying to say and do. On the other hand, we recognized that our brothers and sisters' fears were valid.

We are sharing this information because we reel it is a problem that cerwot be lightly passed over: It touches every homosexual living in our society. We realize that the answer lies not in using a pseudonym but in building a society where the need to concess one's nonresexuality does not exist.
